- Loads peripheral equipment with selected applications such as CD ROM, diskettes, and
 printer paper for operating runs, scanners, back up applications and virus prevention
 software applications on each PC and tests prior to authorizing use.
- Consults with staff about computer problems such as equipment performance, output quality, and maintenance schedule, and coordinates flow of work between shifts to ensure continuity and quick resolution of individual user operational problems.
